At the AGM we asked our members for their suggestions on where they wanted this organization to focus its efforts. The results are as follows.

These topics had more than one person expressing interest in this idea

- Hold more open meetings, BBQ, socials, fundraisers, integrate new arrivals
- Review where our tax dollars are spent, fiscal impacts verse technical aspects of problems
- Take a mediator role as in Cox case, prevent tribunals
- Seminars on pertinent issues with guest speakers, long discussion on issues
- Water taking, (Nestle)
- Mulmur meetings legitimize Mulmur people different venues
- Link to other citizen groups, to cross pollinate and coordinate citizen action
- Be prepared to react to new issues .. they will come up
- Develop relationships with political figures not just at election time – municipal, provincial, federal, chain of political structure
- Increase membership youth
- Noise control
